<p>Writing</p>	<p>We will be learning to write:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Labels • Captions • A Formal Letter (KS1)
<p>Phonics Spelling Punctuation and Grammar</p>	<p>EYFS - weeks 1-3 lots of mark making and learning to recognise and start to write their names KS1 - Year 1 will review phonics phases 2-5 and begin Phase 6 including the spelling of high frequency words / common exception words. Year 2 will start the Non Nonsense Year 2 Spelling programme which includes phonics revision Phases 3-5. <p>Maths</p>	<p>EYFS - Weeks 1-3 Getting to know you! Weeks 3-6 Place Value up to 5</p> <p>KS1 will be learning place value to 10 and 20 (Year 1) and to 100 (Year 2) KS1 will be learning addition and subtraction to 10 (Year 1 and to 100 (Year 2) both including recognising money.</p>

Science	<p>In Science will be investigating a wide range of living things including insects and understanding life processes.</p> <p>We will be working scientifically by asking simple questions, observing closely using simple equipment, performing simple tests gathering and recording data and identifying and classifying.</p>
PSHE	<p>Families and the people who care for us – we will learn to identify people who love and care for us and their roles.</p> <p>Caring Friendships – we will identify what makes a good friend and how we make friends.</p>
History *	<p>We will learn to show an understanding of the concept of nation and a nation's history in particular the history of our own families and the concept of monarchy, democracy, war and peace.</p> <p>We will investigate and interpret the past and understanding our past comes from an interpretation of the available evidence. We will ask questions such as: What was it like for people? How long ago? What happened?</p>
RE	<p>We will learn to understand there are different religions and beliefs.</p> <p>Our focus this term will be on key teachings of Christianity.</p>
Art	<p>Drawing lines of different sizes and thickness, colouring neatly following the lines, showing different tones by using coloured pencil.</p> <p>Jackson Pollock – drip painting. Mixing primary colours to create secondary colours linking and naming colours to feelings.</p>
Computing	<p>We will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay Safe online • Create short animations • Use the interactive Clever Touch Board for learning
Music and Drama	<p>We will learn new songs, sing existing songs and add music and tap out the rhythms.</p>
