Year 2 will start the Non Nonsense Year 2 Spelling programme which includes phonics revision Phases 3-5. Maths	EYFS - Weeks 1-3 Getting to know you! Weeks 3-6 Place Value up to 5 KS1 will be learning place value to 10 and 20 (Year 1) and to 100 (Year 2) KS1 will be learning addition and subtraction to 10 (Year 1 and to 100 (Year 2) both including recognising money.

Science	In Science will be investigating a wide range of living things including insects and understanding life processes. We will being working scientifically by asking simple questions, observing closely using simple equipment, performing simple tests gathering and recording data and identifying and classifying.
PSHE	Families and the people who care for us – we will learn to identify people who love and care for us and their roles. Caring Friendships – we will identify what makes a good friend and how we make friends.
History *	We will learn to show an understanding of the concept of nation and a nation's history in particular the history of our own families and the concept of monarchy, democracy, war and peace. We will investigate and interpret the past and understanding our past comes from an interpretation of the available evidence. We will ask questions such as: What was it like for people? How long ago? What happened?
RE	We will learn to understand there are different religions and beliefs. Our focus this term will be on key teachings of Christianity.
Art	Drawing lines of different sizes and thickness, colouring neatly following the lines, showing different tones by using coloured pencil. Jackson Pollock - drip painting. Mixing primary colours to create secondary colours linking and naming colours to feelings.
