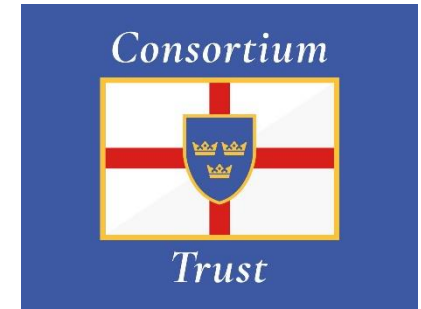


COVID-19 - Response to Phased Re-opening

For the 1st June (Tuesday 2nd June)

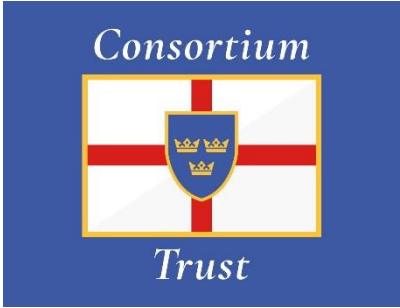


Primary schools are planning, subject to government confirmation and capacity, to welcome back children in:

- ✓ Nursery
- ✓ Reception
- ✓ Year 1
- ✓ Year 6

Alongside full-time provision for priority groups.





To reduce risk, please bring in...

- ✓ Water Bottle with your name on.
- ✓ Coat, only if needed.

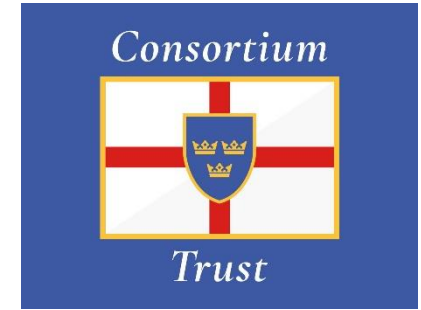
Please do not bring in:

- ❓ Any bags that are not necessary including PE kits.
- ❓ Reusable Packed lunch boxes.



To reduce risk...

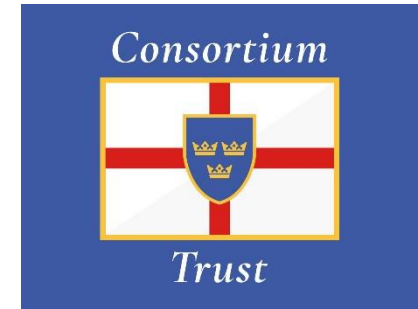
New clothes every day



- ✓ Please ensure you come in freshly cleaned clothes every day.
- ✓ We have asked pupils to also arrive in clean clothes each day.
- ✓ Uniform or close to uniform as possible.



If it looks like it will be sunny...

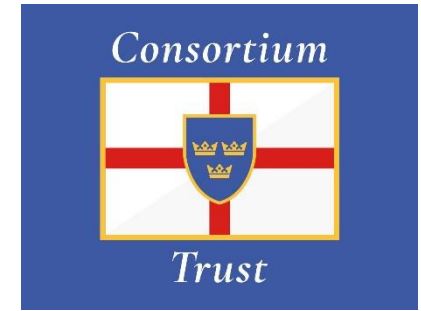


- ✓ Please ensure your child has sun cream on before the school day starts. We cannot put this on for your child.
- ✓ Ensure your child has a hat and appropriate clothing.
- ✓ Remember a named water bottle.



To reduce risk

When pupils come the school...



Please **do NOT...**

- ❓ **Touch any doors, gates or items around the school.**
- ❓ Stand around in groups.
- ❓ **Gather at the classroom door.**
- ❓ Enter the site at times outside those for pick up /drop off.
- ❓ **Parents - enter the office or any part of the school building.**



Next is what we need you to do...



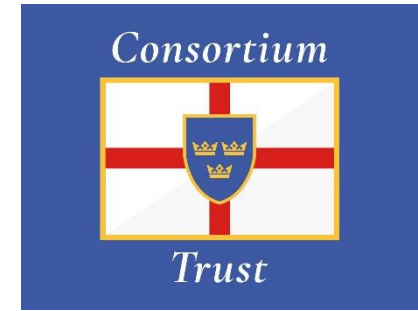
To reduce risk

When coming into the school...

- ✓ **Space yourselves out at least 2m from other families.**
- ✓ **Very quickly drop off.**

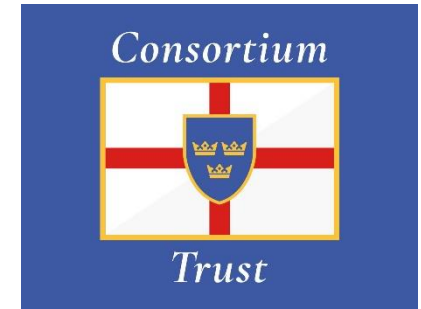


2 metres (6 feet)



To reduce risk

When coming to school...

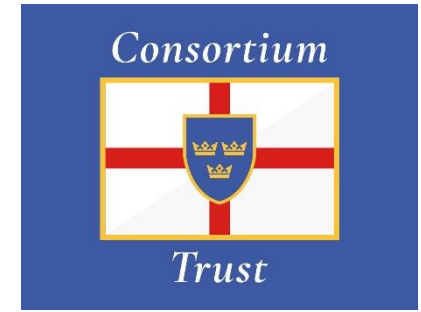


- ✓ **No conversations with staff or other parents at the gate.**
- ✓ **Phone the office if you wish to make an appointment.**
- ✓ **Use the specified entrance/exit.**
- ✓ **Pupils will enter the grounds on their own.**

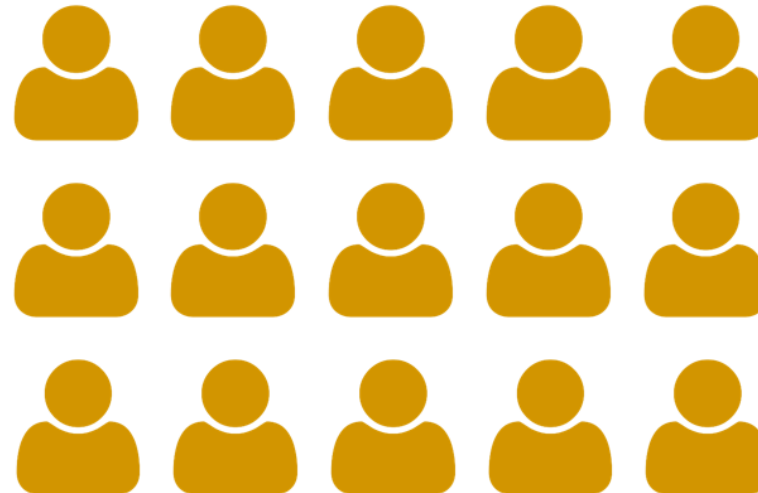


To reduce risk In classrooms...

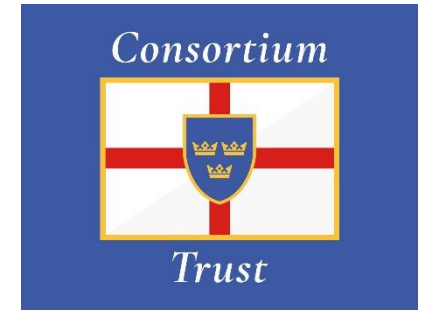


Your child may not be taught by their class teacher.

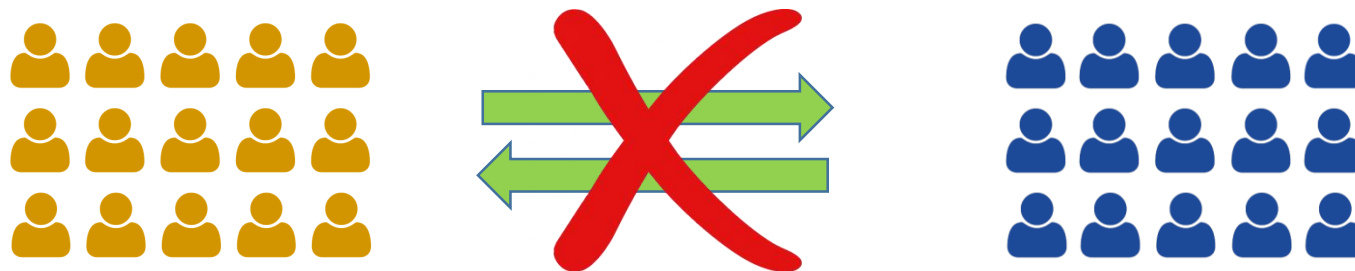
This is because we are **reducing group sizes as much as possible.**



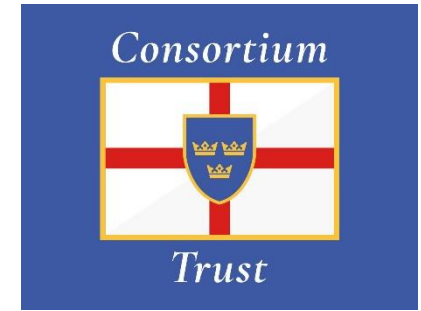
To reduce risk In classrooms...



- ✓ **There is a separate first aid kit for the group.**
- ✓ **PPE is available to staff who need to give first aid.**
- ✓ Your child will **only learn and play with the children in their group** – this will reduce the risk.



To reduce risk In classrooms...

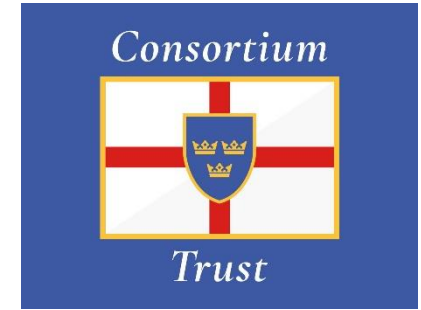


- ✓ Tables are as far apart as possible – **preferably 2m+ apart.**
- ✓ Children will be **given their own equipment and packs to use.**
- ✓ There will be a **maximum of 15 children in a room.**
- ✓ We may use temporary accommodation.



To reduce risk

At lunchtimes...

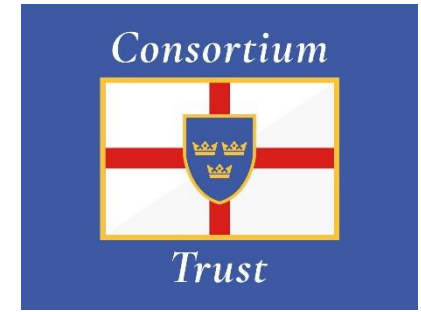


FOOD:

- ✓ Children will eat lunch within the same groups
- ✓ Lunches are eaten in the classrooms at tables or outside.

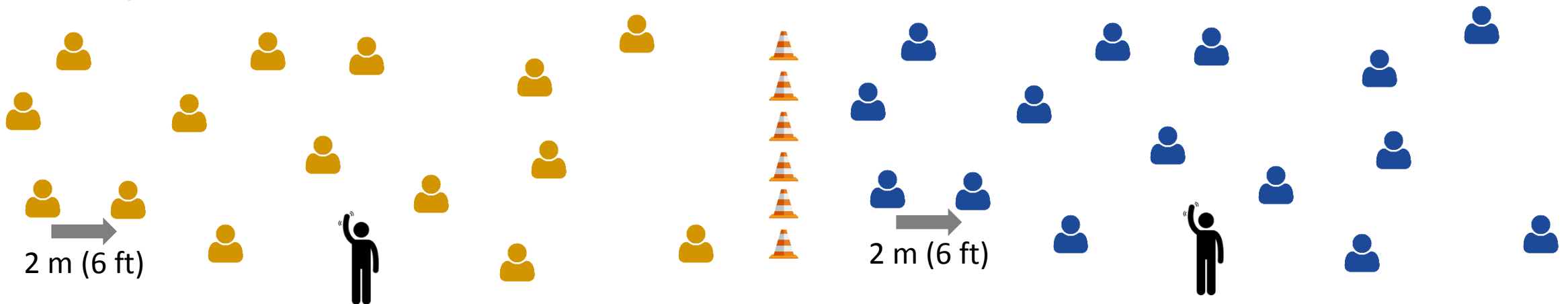


To reduce risk At lunchtimes...



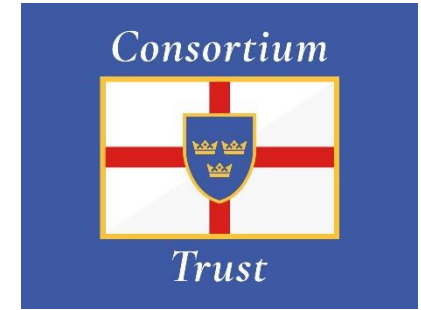
PLAY:

- ✓ The group of up to 15 will have their own separate play space.
- ✓ They will not be mixing with others in different groups.
- ✓ They will be allocated the same adults at lunchtimes where possible.



To reduce risk

Also...



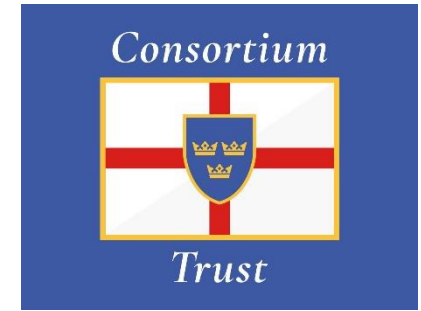
We will ensure that all adults and children:

- ✓ frequently wash their hands with soap and water for 20 seconds and dry thoroughly.
- ✓ clean their hands on arrival at the setting, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing.
- ✓ are encouraged not to touch their mouth, eyes and nose.
- ✓ use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze and use bins for tissue waste ('catch it, bin it, kill it').



To reduce risk

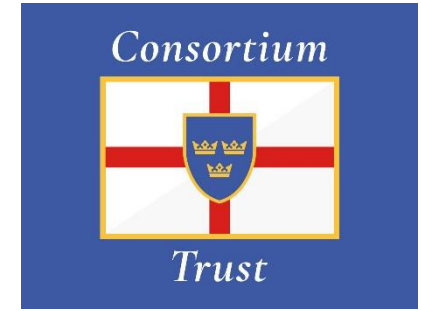
If someone is showing symptoms of COVID-19



- ✓ We have a **separate room for isolation with an adult.**
- ✓ We will call all listed adults until contact is made – please ensure your phone number is up to date and available.
- ✓ **We will use PPE** if we need to be within 2m to help your child.
- ✓ There will be **separate toilet facilities (where possible)** for a child who is showing symptoms.



Pick Up and Drop off times:



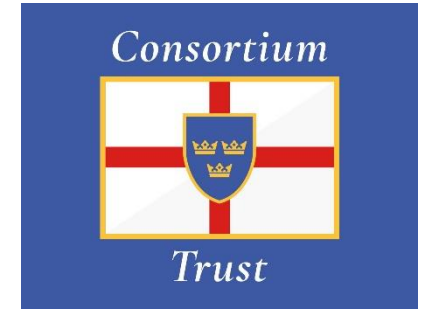
Drop Off

- ✓ All pupils will enter through the front gate
- ✓ A member of staff will be there to greet them and direct them
- ✓ Please drop them off and move away as quickly as possible to avoid queuing down the street
- ✓ Gates will be open from 8.30am until 8.55am

Pick Up

- ✓ All pupils will be dismissed through the gate into the EYFS area
- ✓ Please space yourself out whilst waiting for your child

Entry and Exit points:

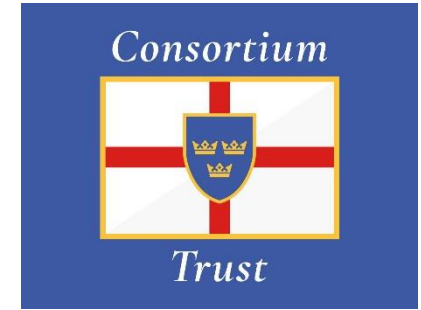


When entering the school building, pupils will use the following entrances

- **Y6 – door leading into Maple Classroom**
- **Rec/Year 1 –door leading into Ash Class**
- **Other pupils – door leading into Ash Class**



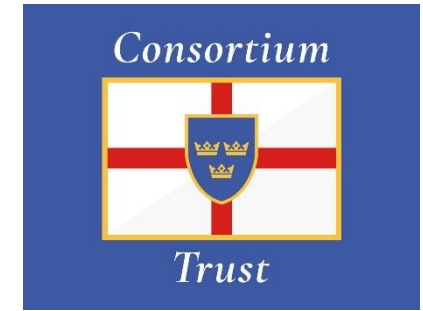
