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Dear Parents and Carers,

It's lovely to be back after the holidays; seeing the children skip into the playground with beaming smiles and all their news.

To celebrate and share their news, Spruce class have been writing recounts. They have edited and improved these by adding time adverbials and opening and closing paragraphs. They will be moving on to write persuasive texts about why they should be school council representatives or head boy or girl.

In Maths, children in all year groups are working on place value- a solid knowledge of which is required to underpin all mathematical learning.
