SCHOOL UNIFORM

I would like to remind you the uniform requirements at Middleton Primary School. We, as do all the schools in our academy trust, insist on children wearing their full and correct uniform and footwear, in line with our uniform expectations.

School uniform is an important part of school life as it helps to create and foster a sense of community and a feeling of belonging. It demonstrates to children that there are codes of conduct and dress in society, especially in the working environment. We ask that all parents support us in ensuring that their children wear the correct uniform and are smart and presentable. We ask the children to ensure that they take care of their uniform and take pride in their appearance.

The uniform consists of a burgundy cardigan or sweatshirt, preferably with the school logo, a white polo shirt or shirt, and grey or black trousers, skirt/pinafore dress or smart shorts. Black shoes, not brightly coloured fashion trainers, should also be worn. For PE, the children only wear the school PE uniform – black joggers, or shorts, a white polo short or t-shirt and plain dark hoodie or sweatshirt. Please in future bring your PE kit to change into. Likewise, please do not come to school all day in your scout/cub uniform, bring it to change into.

Please also remember, we do have our 'Pop-Up Uniform Shop' selling a range of preloved uniform –always open during school hours!

Thank you for your support, ensuring school policies are respected and making sure your child is dressed appropriately for school each day.
